**RESOLUTION TERMINATING A DECLARATION
OF A WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY IN
COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 10, ZONE A**

The following Resolution is now offered and read:

WHEREAS, on March 23, 1993, the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors approved a resolution declaring a water shortage emergency in Waterworks District No. 8 (now County Service Area No. 10, Zone A (CSA 10A)) and approved a Policy on Issuing Water Service Will-Serve Letters (1993 Policy); and

WHEREAS, the declaration of a water shortage emergency was based on a threatened emergency as it was anticipated that the water demand in the near future could exceed the available water supply; and

WHEREAS, the 1993 Policy restricted the issuance of Water Service Will-Serve Letters (Will-Serves) based on the possibility that the demand for future will-serves could exceed the maximum number of will-serves that could be issued due to a limited water supply; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2004, the Board approved certain supplemental water policies directing Public Works staff to pursue supplemental water from the Nacimiento Water Project and to work with the Department of Planning and Building to develop updated water service will serve policies for CSA 10A; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2006, CSA 10A entered into an agreement to obtain 25 acre-feet per year of water from the Nacimiento Water Project; and

WHEREAS, also on October 24, 2006, CSA 10 entered into an agreement with the City of San Luis Obispo for the exchange of up to 160 acre-feet per year of Whale Rock Reservoir water for up to 160 acre-feet per year of Nacimiento Project water on a one-to-one exchange basis; and

WHEREAS, now that the Nacimiento Water Project has been completed, the ordinary demands and requirements of water consumers of CSA 10A can be satisfied without depleting CSA 10A's water supply to the extent that there would be insufficient water for human consumption, sanitation, and fire protection; and.

WHEREAS, now that the water shortage emergency conditions described in California Water Code Sections 350 et seq. no longer exist in CSA 10A, it is now appropriate to terminate the water shortage emergency; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to have the Resolution Declaring a Water Shortage Emergency Condition in Waterworks District No. 8 (now County Service Area No. 10A) terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, acting as the governing board of County Service Area No. 10A, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Sections 350 et seq of the California Water Code, a water shortage emergency in County Service Area No. 10A is hereby declared to no longer exist and the Resolution Declaring a Water Shortage Emergency Condition in CSA 10A dated March 23, 1993, is hereby terminated.
