RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER/SEALER TO ENTER INTO ENFORCEMENT AND SERVICE AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AND THE CALIFORNIA AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONERS AND SEALERS ASSOCIATION

The following resolution is offered and read:

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture finds mutual benefit in agreements including but not limited to grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding for: Exclusion-Interior; Ship and Aircraft Inspection; Pest Management; Egg Certification, Surveillance and Quality Control; and may find benefit in further Exclusion; Pest Management; Eradication and Control Programs; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Protection Agency, and the California Department of Pesticide Regulation finds mutual benefit in agreements including but not limited to grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding for Pesticide Use Enforcement; Pesticide Residue Sampling; Pesticide Use Reporting; Pest Management and Biological Control; and may find benefit in further Pest Management; Biological Control; and Agricultural Chemical survey Programs; and

WHEREAS, The California Department of Food and Agriculture finds mutual benefit in agreements including but not limited to grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding for: Plant Pest/Disease Prevention; Agricultural Chemical Surveys; Biological Control; Nursery Services; Detection Trapping; Fruit, Nut,

Honey, Vegetable and Egg Quality Control; Commissioner Salary Subvention; Bee Control and Eradication; and may find benefit in further Plant Pest/Disease Detection and Prevention; Biological Control; Nursery and Seed Services; Salary Subventions; Pest Management and Control; Agricultural Chemical Surveys; Apiary Protection; Fruit, Nut, Honey, and Egg Quality Control Programs; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation finds mutual benefit in agreements including but not limited to grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding for: Noxious Weed Control; and may find benefit in other Pest Management Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Measurement Standards of the California Department of Food and Agriculture finds mutual benefit in agreements including but not limited to grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding for Weights and Measures Quantity Control verification; Petroleum Inspection; Weighmaster Inspection; and may find benefit in other Weights and Measures Enforcement programs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs and the structural Pest Control Board finds mutual benefit in agreements including but not limited to grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding for Pesticide Use Enforcement; Administration of Applicator Examinations; and may find benefit in other Pesticide Programs; Examinations; and Consumer Protection Activities: and

WHEREAS, the California Agricultural Commissioners and Sealers Association finds mutual benefit in agreements including but not limited to grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding for administration of pesticide use record management programs: and

WHEREAS, funds derived from grants, contracts, cooperative agreements, memoranda of understanding and the Agreements, Programs, and Activities are budgeted as revenues in the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer's budget and are payable to the County General Fund for supporting and enhancing the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer's work; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo finds that the aforesaid services are proper and appropriate public services for the County to provide and seek supporting funding from the aforementioned agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

1. That the recitals set forth here and above are true, correct and valid.

2. The Board of Supervisors hereby grants authority to the San Luis Obispo County Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures to enter into and execute enforcement and service agreements (including grants, contracts, cooperative agreements and Memorandum of Understanding) as described above, which said Agreements directly relate to his/her powers and duties, after review and approval by the Office of County Counsel and the County Administrative Officer on behalf of the County of San Luis Obispo.

3. This Resolution supersedes and replaces Resolution No. 91-560 adopted on November 19, 1991.
