Since 1992, Mr. Brabeck has, as part of his duties as a Pastoral Care Minister with the Old Mission Church in San Luis Obispo, spent nearly every Sunday morning presenting a non-denominational religious service to the minors detained in the County Juvenile Hall. In addition, he has mentored countless detained minors. Mr. Brabeck's wit, wisdom and easy-going communication style has made him one of our most popular volunteers.

Since 1974, Mr. Brabeck has faithfully served as a Commissioner with the San Luis Obispo County Juvenile Justice Commission. In his role as a Commissioner, Mr. Brabeck has tirelessly advocated for the needs of minors in the Juvenile Justice System. As Commissioner, he helped facilitate the location of the current Juvenile Hall and also worked with community leaders to develop the Children's Services Network.
