We all receive cultural legacy of the past and we must accept the truth of what our legacy has been, what damage we have caused, in order to grow as human beings and move forward together. Dear Board of Supervisors,

I am a board member of the Morro Bay Commercial Fishermen's Organization. The fishing community has been attempting to organize a mitigation plan with PG&E since last August 2011 when we heard of their plans. PG&E has met with a small group of fishermen 3 maybe 4 times since then. They waited until June 2012 to meet with the MBCFO board members. We have another meeting planned August 8 or 9th. A mitigation plan is nowhere near established. We have had experience with mitigation plans fairly recently with the Transpacific cable lines. In this situation a fair and reasonable memorandum of understanding was established, a "cable committee" was established, and funds were distributed based on certain qualifications. These funds included funds for the fishermen's losses as well as for research, legal and meeting transportation funds, community funds, and a safety grant. We don't expect the same MOU but something similar. The cable was much less invasive than this study, however, the Cable Companies' mitigation was much more substantial then what PG&E is considering. We hired the attorneys that assisted the fishermen during the cable process, William Walters and Bruce Patterson, in January, but PG&E has not been willing to work with our attorneys on any meaningful level.

PG&E would like to come up with a comparatively small lump sum (with no responsibility for distribution) based on fish data that averages in catches over the last 10 years rather than use current prices and catch. This tends to lower the value of the industry since prices were much different 10 years ago without the "live" fish market prices and regulations greatly altered the catch in the late 90s. MB and Avilla have had to make giant shifts due to the loss of the trawl net fishery to more sustainable fishing gear. 90% of the fishermen now use traps or hook and line. We also had many areas closed due to the Marine Life Protection Act, Cow cod conservation, and Essential Fish Habitat areas being established. Also, many very conservative quotas were established on all our fisheries and most recently the implementation of Catch Shares. We have just started to adjust to all these changes and to significantly increase the value of our fisheries the last few years. In addition, PG&E lowers their mitigation responsibility by basing their estimates on catches that are only in the area of the sounding despite evidence that this level of sounding effects catches over 20 miles away.

With so many protections now in place, the ability of each port has been altered and so our true current ability is difficult to calculate, but I am sure that with close to 120 licensed commercial fishermen as well as the closely tied communities that relies on them , 1.2 million will not come

close to fair reimbursement for their collective potential losses. We question if the value of this test is worth the potential significant environmental and economic impacts but if you think it is absolutely necessary for the local fishing industry to make a tremendous sacrifice for this project, then you should help us make sure PG& E makes a good faith effort to fairly mitigate us. Up to this point they definitely have not!

This attached letter is our attorneys response to the State Lands Commission regarding the draft EIR.

In the first meeting basically two areas were discussed, language of LUO and MND, and how was the Dana going to make it comfortable for the Chumash Community to come and build the Chumash Village. We discussed the narrow window for change in the language, county council suggested some language changes and we said that we would go over them and get back to the county, also the Dana wanted us to put into writing our terms of an MOA and we said that we would. The second meeting was set and then move up several days, we told the county that the new wording had merits but we need to work on the capping recommendation as it was not approved by NCTC. The Dana attorney stated that over 85% of the terms of the suggested MOA would never be acceptable to the Dana, and then went on to do some grandstanding by trying to demean our concerns. The Dana new that NCTC had negotiating team members driving from San Francisco to be at these meetings, as he was present at the first meeting, it is our opinion that the Dana negotiated in Bad Faith, NCTC put a lot of work, time, and money into the coming up with the terms of the MOA they knew that they were not going to agree with the terms of the MOA beforehand, as we had sent the county a draft, (the Dana in the first meeting refused our offer to communicate directly), but they did not let the county know or NCTC, more disrespectful abuse, we are done with their abuse. These people do not deserve the National Educational Grant Funds.

Jim, I am sending you a letter from a person who was there from the beginning, he may shed a little more light on the issues for you.

NCTC is asking that the MND be denied because it is flawed for many reasons.

Honorable Members of the Board:

I am writing to request that you delay action on the Subject Dana Adobe Project until the related differences between the Dana Adobe Amigos (Amigos) and the Northern Chumash Tribal Council (NCTC) can be satisfactorily resolved. Both sides need to come to the table with respect for each other's positions, and with willingness to compromise. It is disturbing to note that NCTC and other Chumash appear to have been initially excluded from the planning process, later included in order to increase the probability of obtaining the grant, and still later excluded as an equal partner once the grant was received. I can understand why NCTC feels that they have been "used" by the Nipomo Amigos.

The Chumash have lived in this area far longer than any other people and have their own story to tell. It would be best if they were involved in the project rather than having their history interpreted strictly by scholars. Please allow them this opportunity by postponing action on the project until both parties can resolve their primary differences.

Although my wife and I currently reside in Utah, we lived and worked on the Central Coast most of our lives before retiring. I am familiar with local archaeology and history, having served as Chief of Cultural Resources for many years at Vandenberg Air Force Base and as an archaeological consultant for many projects in San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara Counties. In fact, I am the one who initially recorded the Chumash Site at the Dana Adobe during an early archaeological reconnaissance in the 1970s. I also visited the site twice around 2005 and 2006 to view volunteer testing of some of the sensitive areas. Beyond that, I have a personal interest in the historical aspects of the Dana Adobe,

as my Paternal Grandfather and his friends from Lompoc drove to the adobe in buggies before or around 1900 to play dance music at the stage stop located there.

All aspects of the history of the Dana Adobe deserve to be featured in the proposed development, and should be told from the point of view of all stakeholders. Please do the right thing and withhold your approval until differences between the major parties have been adequately addressed and everyone has been heard.

I will not be able to attend tomorrow's very important meeting (John's health has not be very good of late) and represent my time with DANA, however, I wanted to share some information with you regarding Fred Collins.

First and foremost, he is not of Chumash ancestry, he is a Yokut from the San Joaquin Valley. The Tulares and Yokuts used to raid the rancho during Captain Dana's time. Also, I want to clarify the difference between a self determination and self identification according to the UN Commission on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples. A self determination must be made by tribal elders and a self identification can be made by an individual, as long as he provides his geneology before a determination can be made. I know that Fred is listed in the County records as an 'elder', but in my opinion that should be removed.

Fred did the same thing in 2008 before the CCHE Board in Sacramento when DANA's Prop 40 grant was to be determined. He has initiated dissention, with no accountability, by spreading animosity with racial overtone throughout the Chumash nation and has recently sent a 14 page email to all. You can expect a large contingent of Chumash at the meeting.

PLEASE ASK HIM WHICH NORTHERN CHUMASH ELDERS HE REPRESENTS AT THE MEETING TOMORROW. YOU SHOULD HAVE A LIST OF ALL THEIR NAMES, THEN ASK IF ANY THE NAMES ARE PRESENT ON THE LIST. IF HE CANNOT NAME ONE, THEN THIS ITEM SHOULD MOVE FORWARD WITH NO MORE SANCTIONS ON DANA.

Please do this for me and DANA.
