Dear SLO County Commissioners,

We have been waiting for the past few years for the county to make a decision on the Excelaron oil drilling project. Our retirement and investment plans depend in large part on that decision.

Frankly, if oil drilling is allowed in the Huasna area, we feel that SLO county will lose much of its appeal as a pleasant place to live. If they can drill in Huasna, then all of the county would be open to demands to allow similar small-scale oil field development. Now we are again facing the possibility of another delay. It is obvious that Excelaron will continue to find reason to delay a decision until they feel conditions are favorable for approval. We urge the Commission to settle this matter without further delay. Out taxes are being spent, a considerable amount of your time is being consumed, and our lives are being negatively affected by by the Excelaron issue.

Please - no more delays. We are in complete agreement with the County Staff and with the Environmental Impact study recommendations - oil drilling in the Huasna Valley is bad for the county and its residents.
