We have watched the Huasna Valley oil exploration & Production project for some time.

Recently the Excelaron Company has asked for an extension of a hearing to allow for adequate time to analyze the alternative site plan for Pad I and Pad II created minimizing significant impacts identified in the Final Environmental Impact Report.

It is our understanding that Excelaron desires to lessen the identified impacts in the Final Environmental Impact Report.

We recall that when the Valley Residents wanted more time to evaluate the project, time extensions have been granted by staff.

It appears to us that the Excelaron Company is trying in every way to accommodate Valley Residents concerns.


