SUBJECT: Request to approve a second amendment to the Multi-Year State Agreement (Clerk's File) with the State Department of Health Care Services for FY 2010-2013, previously amended by the Board on June 19, 2012, to increase the Drug Medi-Cal amount and transfer the contract and Drug Medi-Cal responsibilities from the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs to the Department of Health Care Services, with all other provisions remaining the same

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve and direct Chairperson to sign a second amendment to the Multi-Year State Agreement with the State Department of Health Care Services for FY 2010-2013, previously amended by the Board on June 19, 2012, to increase the Drug Medi-Cal amount and transfer the contract and Drug Medi-Cal responsibilities from the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs to the Department of Health Care Services, with all other provisions remaining the same.

DISCUSSION

Your Board adopted the initial three-year agreement with the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs on June 22, 2010, starting with FY 2010-11 and running through the end of FY 2012-13. On June 19, 2012, your Board approved an amendment for FY 11-12 modifying the terms to facilitate the new provisions enacted with Realignment of 2011.

The second amendment accomplishes the following:

- 1) An increase of \$46,075 to the FY 12-13 State Agreement is to facilitate the reimbursement of Drug Medi-Cal Services provided by the County Office of Education for their Sober School programs; and
- 2) To implement an Absolute Assignment of Agreement transferring the contract and Drug Medi-Cal responsibilities from one State Agency to another. The State Budget Act of 2012 transferred the administrative responsibilities of Drug Medi-Cal from the Department of Alcohol and Drug to the Department of Health Care Services.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

County Counsel has approved the contract as to form and legal effect.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget includes \$46,075 in Medi-Cal revenue for the Drug Medi-Cal services provided by the County Office of Education. The Department of Health Care Services will provide the reimbursement based on Drug Medi-Cal services claimed and provided by County Office of Education's Sober Schools Program.

RESULTS

The outpatient drug-free substance abuse treatment services provided under this contract are part of a larger continuum of care that aims to improve the quality of life of those served. Providing the most appropriate services to the clients increases the probability of positive treatment outcomes. Furthermore, positive treatment outcomes contribute to the wider County vision of a healthy and safe community
