SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution accepting a portion of Willow Road, County Road No. 1073, into the County Maintained Road System, Nipomo. District 4.

RECOMMENDATION

It is our recommendation that your Honorable Board, approve the attached resolution accepting a portion of Willow Road, County Road No. 1073, between Hetrick Avenue and Thompson Avenue in Nipomo into the County Maintained Road System.

DISCUSSION

Willow Road Phase II (Contract WBS 300129) was constructed to enhance circulation within the Nipomo area by extending Willow Road from Hetrick Avenue to Thompson Avenue with an A-1 (rural) County standard roadway and a new interchange with State Route 101. The improvements have been constructed as shown on the plans on file with the Public Works Department, and the road has been open to traffic. We are now recommending that your Board approve the attached resolution to accept the Willow Road extension between Hetrick Avenue and Thompson Avenue into the County Maintained Road System.

Rights of way, necessary for this route, were acquired by previous actions by your Board to accept real property interests granted by various owners along the route. Transfer of right of way to State of California for the Route 101 interchange area will occur in separate action later this year.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

There is no other agency involvement in this matter.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The work to construct this portion of Willow Road Extension Phase II was funded from the Road Impact Fees – Nipomo Area 1, Prop 1B, State and Local Partnership Program, State Transportation Improvement Program, and the Road Fund. Accepting this portion of Willow Road will increase the total mileage of the County Maintained Road System by 1.3 miles. Based on the current average cost per mile, this will increase annual road maintenance costs by \$30,726. To date, this fiscal year's cumulative road maintenance increase resulting from road improvements acceptance is \$33,008.

RESULTS

The result of this action will be to accept this new portion of Willow Road into the County Maintained Road System. This will ensure that this transportation link will serve the public's needs in the future.
