Time is running out for the stakeholders of the Central Coast. There are many inequities. On October 23, 2012, I strongly recommended to the SLO County Board of Supervisors that when the public gets their opportunity to speak on the 10 30 12 agenda item concerning the PG&E

Seismic Survey that they be allowed their **full three minutes**. The most important public reporting opportunities will be closed, including the Coastal Commission, by the time the coastal peoples, (most affected by this Seismic Survey), have official opportunity to have their concerns considered. There will be NO opportunity to download the 10 30 12 public comments on agenda item 22. and have them considered by the Coastal Commission by October 29, 2012. Agenda item 22 is noted as Board Business not the peoples business and NOT a " hearing" as reported in the press.
