Honorable Supervisors;

I am writing with my concerns regarding the Nipomo Park Final EIR and Master Plan that are coming before you on November 6, 2012. You will be voting on whether or not to certify the Final EIR and adopt the Master Plan or one of its 3 alternative plans. Further there are 4 alternate options for a location of a recreational center.

Recreational needs for Nipomo have changed since the Master Plan process began 9 years ago. Our community has added 2 schools with all their extensive athletic amenities. (Olympic swimming pool, football stadium and track, gym with an indoor basket ball court, weight room, volleyball courts, multipurpose field, a handball court, 14 outdoor basketball courts, 6 tennis courts, 5 soccer/baseball fields, amphitheater, theater, and a multipurpose room). We have 3 golf communities with multipurpose rooms. The Black Lake Community has a pool. Our newest community, Trilogy, has 4 tennis courts and a pool. The Jack Reddy Park which will have an approximate 1-acre multiuse field is under development with financial support from the County Parks budget. At the same time our quaint, rural, equestrian community has grown and with the development many of our horse trails and open space parcels have vanished. Recreation has become lop-sided. Our very unique Nipomo Park provides trails for local equestrians and for many in outlying areas who have lost theirs. The needs for ball fields and a pool have diminished while the need to save our last remaining trails has become critical. Nipomo's park equestrian and multiuse trails are not available anywhere else on the mesa. They are irreplaceable and must be preserved. The rural section of the park provides safe corridors for our youth, habitat for wild life, and passive recreation for equestrians, dog walkers, hikers, bird watchers, naturalists and more. Ball fields and other active sports elements need to be built elsewhere and spaced strategically around Nipomo to insure all neighborhoods have access to them. The County needs to explore the purchase of new park land, the acceptance of recreational land from developers, and consider joint use agreements with our schools. Schools with open campuses and active use have less vandalism than those that are closed.

Nipomo's water supply is tenuous at best. It is irresponsible to destroy a well used rural recreational area requiring NO water to build seasonably used ball fields and sports elements that would threaten our already limited water supply.

In the County Final EIR in the Project Description section, page 2-7 (2.1.5 Initial Study) it says. "At the March 2005 meeting, the NCAC objected to the designs being analyzed in the project's environmental document and proposed a "rural friendly" design alternative. In 2006, a draft initial study was

completed by the County's consultant. County staff coordinated with the SCAC and held public meetings in Nipomo on Aug 14 and 21, 2006, to obtain input on the draft initial study. A majority of public comments included requests that the park remain rural with new recreation largely located elsewhere. On August 2, 2006, the majority of the SCAC supported the idea that the park should remain largely rural" A large majority of the community and its elected representatives on the SCAC Board have declared loudly and repeatedly their desires for the Nipomo Park to remain rural and new recreational elements built elsewhere. The park should reflect Nipomo's rural equestrian heritage and character and preserve its open space and multiuse trails for the continued use of the equestrians and nature lovers of today and future generations. This park is a gift and historical gem. Endorse Master Plan Alternative B, the more rural plan which was designated the Environmentally Superior Alternative in the Final EIR. Any of the 4 alternative sites for a recreational center are acceptable.

We used to be able to ride our horses kitty corner from our property to its. Now Camino Caballo is a freeway with all the traffic, from the Woodlands, the new nursery and all the homes that went in during the early 2000's. We now must walk our horses to the park in order for our family to try and stay safe.
