RECOMMENDATION

In accordance with applicable State Law, it is our recommendation that your Honorable Board:

1. Approve the project and adopt the plans and specifications for the construction of Vineyard Drive Bike Lanes from Bethel Road to Ashton Way in Templeton, California, Contract No. 300437; and
2. Authorize the contract to be advertised for construction bids. The recommended bid opening date is Thursday, January 17, 2013; and
3. Provide the Public Works Director, or his designee, the discretion to extend the bid opening date to a date deemed more appropriate by the Director or his designee, so long as any such extension is in compliance with all applicable laws.

DISCUSSION

This project proposes to widen a 0.6 mile portion of Vineyard Drive between Bethel Road and Ashton Way in order to accommodate Class II Bike Lanes. The proposed project fills the gap in bike lanes on Vineyard Drive resulting in a two mile continuous Class II bike lanes from the Vineyard Elementary School to the Templeton High School.

The scope of project construction will include widening the paved roadway, removal of several roadside culverts, and modifications to existing roadside ditches. The work will provide a wider unpaved shoulder along the north side of Vineyard Drive to accommodate pedestrians.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Construction funding is authorized for this project through the Bicycle Transportation Account (BTA) which is administered by Caltrans. Various utility companies have provided appropriate input. No Utility relocations are anticipated. This project is supported by the County Bicycle Advisory Committee and the Templeton Area Advisory Group.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the contract as to legal form and effect.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This project is a multi-year project budgeted in the Roads budget at \$633,000. The total project costs are estimated at \$633,000. Funding for the project will come from State Bicycle Transportation Account (BTA) Grant in the amount of \$569,700 and Road funds in the amount of \$ 63,300.

At the time of Award, when actual project costs are known, we will return to your Board with a budget adjustment, if necessary.

Please see Exhibit "A" for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

RESULTS

Approval of the recommended action will result in this project being advertised for construction bids, and will promote a safer, healthier community.
