RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board review the draft Progress Report, consider public comment, and receive and file.

DISCUSSION

On February 1, 2011 and October 16, 2012, the Information Technology department made presentations to your Board on the topic of Fiber Optics within San Luis Obispo County. At the October 16, 2012 meeting, your Board specifically requested a list of next steps and potential opportunities for the creation of Public-Public or Public-Private partnerships to further expand the reach of Fiber Optics within the County. An outreach effort was immediately conducted that included discussions with school districts, telecommunications carriers, private businesses, County of San Luis Obispo departments, and other governmental agencies. The attached Fiber Optic Progress Report provides the requested list of findings and opportunities.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Various County departments, advisory groups, and agencies were consulted during the development of this Fiber Optic Progress Report.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The Fiber Optic Progress Report does not authorize the expenditure of County funds.

RESULTS

Strategy discussions will enhance communications between your Board and staff while providing an opportunity for your Board to provide feedback and direction that promotes enhanced safety and health of citizens, improved delivery of governmental services, and economic prosperity of the County. The Fiber Optic Progress Report satisfies your Board's request that the Information Technology department return, by the end of calendar year 2012, with a list of projects that could be considered. The Progress Report provides your Board and the public a list of opportunities available within the County.

The comments of the Board of Supervisors will guide the preparation of proposals to be implemented either later in Fiscal Year 2012-13 or proposed as part of the County Budget for Fiscal Year 2013-14.
