## **RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO MICHAEL W. "MIKE" WINN FOR HIS DEDICATION TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO**

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

**WHEREAS**, Michael W. "Mike" Winn has been serving as the Chair of the County's Water Resource Advisory Committee (WRAC) for the past eight years, covering calendar years 2005-2012, and has been an acting member of WRAC since 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, Mike has provided dedicated leadership to the WRAC, promoting inclusivity and collaboration among its members, comprised of elected officials, representing all seven cities, independent special districts, agricultural, and environmental, and building and business stakeholders; and

**WHEREAS**, Mike has also served our local communities in many other ways as well, most prominently as a member of the Board of Directors of the Nipomo Community Services District for the past 12 years but also including, serving as a Board Member on the Nipomo Chamber of Commerce, the Olde Towne Nipomo Association, Nipomo Rotary, Friends of the Nipomo Library, Co-chair of the Nipomo Water Planning Forum, and many others; and

**WHEREAS**, Mike's dedication to communities has gone well beyond our local, state and national boundaries – in 1980 Mike served in a Cambodian refugee camp directing medical relief in conditions that cannot be imagined by anyone other than those who serve in person; and

**WHEREAS**, "Today's Mike" - the "Statesman" - may not be recognizable by those who knew Mike when he was a young world traveler, pursuing love in Asia in the 1960's with nothing but a backpack, a long beard, and some spare change; and

**WHEREAS**, Mike's life experiences also includes over 15 different occupations with diversity that has ranged as wide as his inquiring mind would allow; and

**WHEREAS**, Mike's travels and spirit have spanned the earth, and our communities are ever so fortunate that he returned to the County of his birth, lecturing at Cal Poly for the past 16 years, sharing stories of his life and of course his "perspective" to aspiring students, participating in community and business associations, and leading local government efforts on regional water resource management.
