




San Luis Obispo County 2012 Annual Crop Statistics


MESSAGE FROM THE AG COMMISSIONER

- **Hardcopies of this report will be made available in June**


TEN YEAR TOTAL COMMODITY VALUATION




TEN YEAR CATEGORY COMPARISON








