SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution for the acceptance of road improvements on Limestone Way and Blue Rock Road in Templeton. District 1.

RECOMMENDATION

It is our recommendation that your Honorable Board approve the attached resolution to accept the offer of dedication for Limestone Way and Blue Rock Road, Tract 2475 (also known as Marquita Industrial Park), as shown in Book 27 of Maps at Pages 35 through 37 inclusive.

DISCUSSION

Limestone Way and Blue Rock Road were constructed as subdivision improvements associated with the "Marquita Industrial Park" established by Tract 2475. The improvements have been completed and approved as shown on the plans on file in the County Public Works Department.

Tract 2475 was a twenty lot subdivision for industrial purposes. The subject roads meet the development density criteria for accepting new roads into the County maintained system as established in Resolution 2007-344 approved by the Board of Supervisors on September 11, 2007. We are now recommending that your Board accept the roads into the County maintained road system.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

There is no other agency involvement in this matter.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This work will increase the total mileage of the County-maintained roads by 0.261 miles. Based on the current average cost per mile, this will increase annual road maintenance costs by \$6,016. To date, this fiscal year's cumulative road maintenance increase resulting from road improvements acceptance is \$6,016.

RESULTS

The result of this action will be to accept new roads into the County maintained road system and ensure that these transportation links will be able to serve the public's needs in the future.
