SUBJECT: Submittal of bid opening report for 2013 Micro-Surfacing, Various County Roads and to award the subject contract to Intermountain Slurry Seal, the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$688,120. Districts 1, 2 and 3.

RECOMMENDATION

In accordance with applicable State Law, it is our recommendation that your Honorable Board:

1. Award the subject contract (No. 245R12B614) to Intermountain Slurry Seal, the lowest responsible bidder, at \$688,120. and
2. Authorize the Public Works Director or his designee to approve change orders for a contingency amount up to \$35,000 for a final total construction amount of \$723,120.

DISCUSSION

In accordance with direction from your Board, bids for the subject contract were opened on Thursday, August 8, 2013.

Six bids were received. They are as follows:

Engineer's Estimate	\$ 963,750.00
Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc.	\$ 688,120.00
VSS International, Inc.	755,754.00
Central Valley Engineering and Asphalt, Inc.	865,950.00
Windsor Fuel Co.	876,100.00
California Pavement Maintenance Co., Inc.	947,597.00
American Asphalt South Inc.	1,065,792.00

The low bid came in 28.6% below the Engineer's Estimate. The amount of the low bid compared with the Engineer's Estimate is primarily due to a favorable bidding climate for this type of work. We have reviewed the submittal from Intermountain Slurry Seal and verified that they are the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Project Background Information

This micro-surfacing contract is part of the Department of Public Works Annual Pavement Maintenance Program which provides for the resurfacing of existing paved roads to extend the service life of the pavement. The work is necessary to halt further deterioration of these paved roads, and improve safety and operation. The contract provides for micro-surfacing on 26 miles of various County maintained asphalt concrete roadways. The road segments for resurfacing are selected through the County's Pavement Management System and on-site inspection.

The pavement management strategy used by Public Works is to keep roads with relatively good pavement conditions resurfaced using low-cost approaches such as micro-surfacing. These actions prevent deterioration and need for major rehabilitation in later years. Micro-surfacing provides a durable seal coat to protect the pavement and improve the traffic wearing surface.

This project will be constructed using a combination of County forces and private contractors. County crews prepared the road surface by filling any pot holes and sealing cracks in the pavement. The contractor will then apply the micro-surfacing. This combination is part of the Pavement Management Plan maintenance strategy to increase the overall miles of roadway treated each year.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Various utility companies have been contacted in consideration of project impacts to their facilities. The County Clerk formally processes the bid openings.

The affected area advisory councils have been alerted to this pending construction activity. For Las Tablas Road, special construction periods are established to avoid significant impact to the regional medical facilities.

Caltrans will provide permits for traffic control plans of State highway interchanges and intersections.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is a Pavement Management project budgeted in the Road Fund FY 2013-14. The total project costs are estimated at \$874,301. Funding for the project will come from the Road Fund – Pavement Management Program. No budget adjustment is necessary.

Please see Exhibit A for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

RESULTS

The immediate result of the recommended action will be the construction of this project, which will improve the road for the safety of the motoring public. This, in turn, will result in a safer, more livable community.
