SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution establishing changes to the Traffic Regulations Code east of Arroyo Grande, Cayucos, Los Osos, Nipomo, and south of the City of San Luis Obispo. Districts 2, 3 & 4.

RECOMMENDATION

It is our recommendation that your Honorable Board adopt the attached resolution amending the County's Traffic Regulation Code sections involving angled parking, stop intersections, yield intersections, and no or limited parking zones.

DISCUSSION

The Department of Public Works received requests for action at the following locations:

Stop/Yield Signs at Intersections

Ormonde Road at Old Oak Park Road, Near Arroyo Grande - Old Oak Park Road ends at an uncontrolled intersection along a curve on Ormonde Road. As part of an evaluation of Ormonde Road, Staff reviewed this location and determined that there was a need to place a Yield sign at this intersection to address limited sight distance for the Old Oak Park Road approach.

Ten Oaks Way at Glenhaven Place, Nipomo - Staff received calls from the residents of Ten Oaks Way regarding speed and cut through traffic concerns occurring after Phase 1 Willow Road was opened. While investigating these concerns, Staff evaluated the intersection of Ten Oaks Way and Glenhaven Place. Currently, the intersection is an uncontrolled T intersection with Ten Oaks Way ending at Glenhaven Place. During Staff's review, it was determined that the intersection would benefit from the installation of a stop sign to address sight distance concerns.

Twelfth Street at Santa Ynez Avenue, Los Osos - Twelfth Street is a residential road that ends at Santa Ynez Avenue creating a T intersection. This intersection is uncontrolled. The portion of Santa Ynez Avenue east of the intersection is presently not a county maintained street. Due to the layout of the intersection and traffic volumes, Staff has determined that it is necessary to place a stop sign on Twelfth Street.

Staff recommends your Board adopt the attached resolution to establish Stop or Yield signs at these street intersections.

Establishing Angled Parking Zones

Ocean Boulevard, Cayucos - County Parks recently completed enhancements to the Norma Rose Park. These changes included providing angled parking along the frontage of the park site within the street right of way.

Mallagh Street, Nipomo - The County recently improved the shoulder on Mallagh Street from Day Street to the north end of the road to accommodate community members accessing the Nipomo High School sports fields from this location. This widened shoulder creates the ability for perpendicular parking and increases the number of vehicles that can park at this location.

Staff recommends your Board adopt the attached resolution to allow for angled parking at these locations.

Establishing Restricted Parking Zones

Lopez Drive at Cecchetti Road - Public Works received a call about parked vehicles obstructing the sight distance at the intersection of Lopez Drive and Cecchetti Road. Staff reviewed this location and determined that there is limited sight distance when cars are parked along the south east side of the intersection. A restriction of parking at this location is warranted and the adjoining land owner has been made aware of the situation.

Magenta Lane, Nipomo - Staff was contacted by the Nipomo Post Office about removing a parking restriction on Magenta Lane. The parking restriction was originally established due to the width of the road and the lack of a turnaround at the end of the road. Since the Post Office driveway is being used for the turnaround, the need for a parking restriction on both sides of the road has been eliminated.

Santa Fe Road, South of the City of San Luis Obispo - Staff has reviewed comments regarding the parking of vehicles along Santa Fe Road. The concerns were that due to the high number of trucks and the number of parked vehicles, the road was not wide enough to support parking on both sides. Staff reviewed the road and determined that eliminating parking on the south side was necessary to guarantee two travel lanes remain open.

Buckley Road, South of the City of San Luis Obispo - Public Works is working on a project to widen Buckley Road from Buttonwood Way to Thread Lane. This project will include a two way left turn lane and four foot shoulders. As part of this project parking will have to be restricted along the south side of the road. Staff has reviewed the road and determined that even without the proposed widening project restricting the parking is necessary to improve the sign distance for the existing driveways along this road. The adjoining property owner has been made aware of this action and supports the elimination parking for enhanced safety.

Ontario Road at Higuera Street, South of the City of San Luis Obispo - Staff received complaints that overnight camping is causing security and sanitation concerns of residents and attendees of the Johnson Ranch trail head. Also the County is concerned that the increased uses of the trail head will lead to obstructed intersection sight distance due to vehicle parking. Staff reviewed these complaints

with City of San Luis Obispo staff and the Avila Valley Advisory Council. All parties are in agreement that a no parking zone should be established at the intersection of Higuera Street and Ontario Road; and that a no overnight parking zone be established for sections of Ontario Road including the existing widened shoulder area currently being used as trail head parking.

Staff recommends your Board adopt the attached resolution to establish no parking zones at these locations.

Adoption of these regulations does not require a public hearing.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The California Highway Patrol and the Sheriff's Department will enforce these restrictions, once posted. The Advisory Councils have been made aware of the changes in their areas.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Placement of signs is estimated to cost approximately \$2,500. This is within the Road Fund's budgeted amount for this activity.

RESULTS

Adoption of this Resolution will enhance County road safety and operations by assuring traffic flow, room for emergency vehicle response, and improved pedestrian access, thus improving community livability.
