WHEREAS, Lisa has been an enthusiastic advocate for the children in foster care, care coordinating an estimated 1,400 children over the years of her tenure here; and

WHEREAS, Lisa will be missed for her posted news article, quote "If you think you are having a bad day, remember the woman who gave birth after four days in a tree to escape floods"; and

WHEREAS, Lisa will now be free to take every trip imaginable to unknown parts of the world, visit friends in Paris, take long walks in the morning and swim in the afternoon, dote on her Dad and play auntie to her niece's new baby; and

WHEREAS, The County of San Luis Obispo, the Public Health Department and the Department of Social Services have been fortunate to have Lisa's knowledge and wisdom over the years providing advocacy for children and the HCPCFC program in San Luis Obispo County.
