SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution authorizing execution of notice of completion and acceptance for the widening of Templeton Road from Bluebird Hill Lane to South El Pomar near Templeton. District 5.

RECOMMENDATION

It is our recommendation that your Honorable Board adopt the attached resolution, which authorizes the execution and acceptance of a Notice of Completion for the Construction of the Widening of Templeton Road from Bluebird Hill Lane to South El Pomar near Templeton (No. 300386).

DISCUSSION

The Templeton Road Widening Project improved a 0.6 mile portion of Templeton Road between South El Pomar and Bluebird Hill Lane. The project provides two 12-foot wide travel lanes with a 4-foot minimum paved shoulder. The Project's goal has been to improve safety by providing recovery area for vehicles along Templeton Road, as well as improving shoulder width for cyclists. The construction included cutting back existing roadway slopes, placing fill in low areas, removal of roadside obstacles, realigning an existing roadside ditch, and replacing several culverts.

The project also involved right of way acquisition of a dozen parcels to provide the necessary width for widening. Replacement trees are being planted off-site to mitigate for tree loss as a result of the project.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Caltrans authorized construction funding for this project and acted, on behalf of the Federal Highway Administration, as the lead Federal agency.

The California Department of Fish and Game (now California Department of Fish and Wildlife), Army Corps of Engineers, and the Regional Water Quality Control Board had issued necessary permits and project conditions. Various utility companies (AT&T, PG&E, and Nacimiento Water Pipeline) have provided appropriate input and performed their relocations where necessary.

The Templeton Area Advisory Group has been kept apprised of the project scope and schedule.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the contract as to legal form and effect.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is a multi-year project in the Road Fund FY 2013-14 budget at \$1,725,177 (WBS 300386). The total project costs are estimated at \$1,725,177. Funding for the project will come from Proposition 1B, Federal High Risk Rural Road Program (HRRR) and the Road Fund.

A final report of actual project costs will be filed with the clerk after any and all claims, disputes and adjustments have been resolved. We do not anticipate the final project cost to differ materially from the current estimated total. Five percent (5%) of total contractor payments are held by the County and released only after meeting the legal holding period after the Notice of Completion is filed.

Please see Exhibit "A" for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

RESULTS

By taking the recommended action, your Board will cause the legal Notice of Completion for this construction contract to be recorded, and start the period of time during which liens can be filed by subcontractors against the prime contractor.
