RESOLUTION AMENDING EMPLOYEE PENSION RATE CONTRIBUTIONS FOR  
EMPLOYEES IN BU 07-LAFCO OPERATIONS & STAFF MANAGEMENT, BU 17-  
COURTS INTERPRETER, BU 18-COURTS TECHNICAL-SEIU, BU 19-COURTS  
SUPERVISORY-SLOCEA, BU 20-COURTS COURT EMPLOYEES-SEIU, BU 24-COURTS  
GENERAL MANAGEMENT, BU 25-COURTS COMMISSIONERS & ATTORNEYS, BU 26-

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, the San Luis Obispo County Employees Retirement Plan provides for Contracting Agencies participation in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the current Contracting Agencies in the San Luis Obispo County Employees Retirement Plan as Miscellaneous Members include the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Luis Obispo County, the Superior Court of California for San Luis Obispo County, and the Air Pollution Control District for San Luis Obispo County; and

WHEREAS, the Normal Rate of Contribution for Miscellaneous Members are set forth in Appendix A to the San Luis Obispo County Employees Retirement Plan; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the San Luis Obispo County Employees Retirement Plan include an amendment to Appendix A – Miscellaneous Members Contribution Rates and Appendix A Tier 2 – Miscellaneous Members Contribution Rates; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California as follows:

1. That the recitals set forth hereinabove are true, correct, and valid; and
2. That effective the pay period that includes January 1, 2014, the members of the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Luis Obispo County bargaining units designated as “Miscellaneous” members shall receive an employee pension rate increase of 0.48% resulting from the 2012 actuarial report by the Pension Trust. A corresponding increase of 0.49% in the amount the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Luis Obispo County appropriates to the Pension Trust will also be implemented; and
3. That effective the pay period that includes January 1, 2014, the members of the Superior Court of California for San Luis Obispo County bargaining units designated as “Miscellaneous” members shall receive an employee pension rate increase of 0.32% resulting from the 2012 actuarial report by the Pension Trust. A corresponding increase of 0.65% in the amount the Superior Court of California for San Luis Obispo County appropriates to the Pension Trust will also be implemented; and
4. That effective the pay period that includes January 1, 2014, the members of the Air Pollution Control District for San Luis Obispo County bargaining units designated as “Miscellaneous” members shall receive an employee pension rate increase of 0.00% resulting from the 2012 actuarial report by the Pension Trust. A corresponding increase of 0.97% in the amount the Air Pollution Control District for San Luis Obispo County appropriates to the Pension Trust will also be implemented; and
5. That the San Luis Obispo County Employees Retirement Plan is hereby amended to include revisions to Appendix A – Miscellaneous Members Contribution Rates (A.M.07.LAFCO, A.M.07.LAFCOA, A.M.17.C, A.M.18.C, A.M.19.C, A.M.20.C, A.M.24.C, A.M.25.C, A.M.26.C, A.M.27.C, A.M.98 – APCD, A.M.99 – APCD, and A.M.99.A – APCD) and Appendix A Tier 2 – Miscellaneous Members Contribution Rates (T2- A.M.98 – APCD, and T2- A.M.99 – APCD); and
6. That Appendix A – Miscellaneous Members Contribution Rates (A.M.07.LAFCO, A.M.07.LAFCOA, A.M.17.C, A.M.18.C, A.M.19.C, A.M.20.C, A.M.24.C, A.M.25.C, A.M.26.C, A.M.27.C, A.M.98 – APCD, A.M.99 – APCD, and A.M.99.A – APCD) and Appendix A Tier 2 – Miscellaneous Members Contribution Rates (T2- A.M.98 – APCD, and T2- A.M.99 – APCD) to the San Luis Obispo County

Employees Retirement Plan be revised.
