


Dear Mr. O'Quest

The Cambria Community Services District (Cambria CSD) has been in the process of adopting and amending at the 2013 California Fire Code, the 2012 International Wildland Urban Interface Code. This adoption includes appendices, annual supplements, State amendments, local amendments and errata.

In order to place requirements that are more restrictive than these code provisions, on November 21, 2013 the Cambria CSD Board of Directors also approved and adopted Resolutions 45-2013 which approved the necessary findings as required by the California Health and Safety Code section 13869.7.

The timeline for the Cambria CSD hearings and adoptions is as follows:

1. Resolution 45-2013 was presented, heard and approved at the November 21, 2013 Cambria CSD Board of Directors meeting. This resolution approved the necessary findings to amend and adopt fire and life safety requirements that are more restrictive than the California Fire Code and the International Wildland Urban Interface Code.
2. On December 2, 2013, copies of the 2013 California Building Code, 2013 California Fire Code Fire Code and the 2012 International Wildland Urban Interface Code were made available for public viewing at the Cambria CSD business office at 1316 Tamson Drive and Cambria CSD Fire Department at 2850 Burton Drive in Cambria.
3. A copy of our proposed ordinance and the findings was sent to the San Luis Obispo County Fire Department and San Luis Obispo County Building Division for review on November 22, 2013 as required by the California Health and Safety Code.
4. Ordinance 05-2013 was presented at the Cambria CSD Board of Directors meeting – November 21, 2013. At the meeting, the proposed ordinance was read, discussed and introduced. Ordinance 05-2013 will adopt and amend the 2013 California Fire Code and the 2012 International Wildland Urban Interface Code, including all appendices, annual supplements, State amendments, local amendments and errata.
5. Ordinance 05-2013 was presented at a public hearing at the December 19, 2013 Cambria CSD Board of directors meeting and was adopted by the Board.
6. The Cambria CSD Clerk and I assembled all of the necessary documents that have been included in this packet.


In order for the proposed fire code adoption and local amendments to take effect, the San Luis Obispo County board of Supervisors must approve and ratify this code adoption as required by the California Health and Safety Code section 13869.7.

I have discussed our adoption and local amendment package with Cal Fire/San Luis Obispo County Fire representatives and the San Luis Obispo County Building division. Fire Prevention Battalion Chief, Laurie Donnely, Fire Chief Rob Lewin and Supervising Plans Analyst Steve Hicks have reviewed our proposed amendments and findings and are supportive of them. We have also made efforts to more closely align with San Luis Obispo County amendments locally for 2013.

Attached with this letter are all the necessary documents to verify the process and action taken by the Cambria CSD to legally approve and implement the new Fire Codes as required by California State Law. Should you require any additional documentation or assistance please contact me.
