SUBJECT: Request to approve a resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to enter into a contract with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation for temporary emergency housing of juveniles. All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to enter into a contract with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation for temporary emergency housing of juveniles.

DISCUSSION

Section 850 of the California Welfare and Institutions Code provides that the county shall provide for a Juvenile Hall for the detention of wards and other minors who may be within the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court.

A circumstance may develop indicating that the Juvenile Hall is inadequate or unsafe because of a natural or manmade disaster, or that the continued presence of a given minor presents a significant risk of violence or escape.

In such cases, section 1752.15 of the Welfare and Institutions Code provides that the county may contract with the California Youth Authority, now the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, for the temporary emergency housing of minors.

The contract does not obligate the county, but merely authorizes the County to utilize temporary emergency housing services, if needed.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

County Counsel has approved the resolution and contract as to form and legal effect.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This agreement is limited to \$10,414.80, which is budgeted in the Probation Department's current budget.

RESULTS

This item will allow the Chief Probation Officer to utilize temporary emergency housing services for juveniles at the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, if needed.
