Emergency Flooding Plan

If the 7 day weather forecast calls for significant flooding of the Salinas River, we will start to prepare for implementing our flood plan.

If the immediate weather forecast calls for continued flooding, the following steps will be taken to ensure the safety of the pets in our care:

1. The dogs will be relocated to 9410 Asuncion Rd., which is a back up boarding facility and has the capacity to accommodate many dogs.
2. The owners of the relocated pets will be notified of our actions.
3. **Aaron Mills** will be contacted by telephone at **805-610-2740** to remove the panels from the building to allow the flow of water to continue uninterrupted. If he is unable to be reached at the number, see alternate contacts listed below.
4. We will check the premises for any other equipment/supplies that need to be evacuated from the area
5. The occupants of the house on the property will be notified to watch for any signs of problems on the premises and will be instructed to notify us at once.
