RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MARCH 25, 2014 “NATIONAL AGRICULTURE DAY” AND MARCH 23-29, 2014 AS “NATIONAL AGRICULTURE WEEK” IN SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY.

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS; National Agriculture Week is celebrated every year to honor agriculture for providing safe, abundant and affordable products, a strong economy, a source of renewable energy, and a world of job opportunities; and

WHEREAS; San Luis Obispo County’s diversified agriculture provides a strong base for our local economy with total annual economic contributions of over \$ 1.87 billion and the creation of over 20,000 local jobs; and

WHEREAS, California leads the nation in farm production for more than 60 years and the state’s farmers and ranchers have led the U.S. in the production of over 400 separate commodities, and

WHEREAS, California’s farmers and ranchers, who represent less than 1 percent of the state’s total population, contribute nearly \$44.7 billion in high-quality food, fiber, forest products and flowers annually, and

WHEREAS, California’s farmland, fertile soils, forgiving climates, agricultural technology and innovation allow each California farmer to produce food and fiber for 155 people, and

WHEREAS, California agriculture is a renewable economic resource for the state, creating income that is replenished annually, and

WHEREAS, farmers and ranchers provide a bounty of products while protecting the environment through the wise management of natural resources, and

WHEREAS, California agriculture is a family affair with about 97 percent of all farms being operated as family farms or partnerships, and

WHEREAS, San Luis Obispo County’s agricultural industry, valued at over \$861 million, produces a bounty of high quality commodities such as strawberries, cattle, broccoli and vegetable transplants, and is a vital and vibrant contributor to our local economy and our way of life, and

WHEREAS; the agriculture community engages tens of thousands of volunteers and organizations such as the San Luis Obispo Chapter of California Women for Agriculture to help educate their members, policymakers and the consumer about agriculture’s role in America, so therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors recognizes the contributions and honors the achievements of farmers, ranchers and the 1.1 million people involved in jobs relating to California agriculture, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that March 25, 2014 be declared National Agriculture Day and March 23-29, 2014 be declared National Agriculture Week in San Luis Obispo County and encourages members of the public to participate in activities that acknowledge, support to celebrate the achievements of the men and women who work throughout the year in state’s number-one industry.
