## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the appointments of Anne Robin and Wendy Tyree to the Homeless Services Oversight Council (HSOC) for terms expiring on 1/1/2017. Anne Robin will fill the vacancy left by Jeff Hamm and Wendy Tyree will fill the vacant Faith-based seat.

## **DISCUSSION**

The composition of HSOC is meant to be diversified, using the collaboration of individuals and agencies to provide guidance and oversight for the on-going implementation of the 10-Year Plan to End Homelessness.

Efforts to achieve full membership for the HSOC are ongoing and this item recommends two applicants for appointment to a vacant County Government seat and a vacant Faith-based seat. Anne Robin is recommended to fill the seat that was vacated by Jeff Hamm due to term expiration. Wendy Tyree is recommended to fill a vacancy in the Faith-based seat on the HSOC.

Anne Robin is currently the Behavioral Health Administrator for San Luis Obispo County and has worked in the field of public behavioral health for 30 years. She developed the AB2034 program for Stanislaus County through a contractor organization (Telecare), and the first Full Service Partnership team for homeless mentally ill persons in the State. In addition, she served on the Continuum of Care governing board in Modesto and assisted in the development of the housing plan for Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) funding in Tuolumne County as Assistant Behavioral Health Director. As Behavioral Health Director in Butte County, Ms. Robin assisted with program development and oversight for MHSA funding; including grants to local homeless shelters and other assistance.

Wendy Tyree has been on the Interfaith Coalition for the Homeless board for one year as well as acting as the October Homeless Overflow Program Coordinator at the Unitarian Universal Fellowship of San Luis Obispo. In addition Ms. Tyree has been a coordinator for the San Luis Obispo People's Kitchen for over a year, assisting with emergency or unexpected calendar vacancies. She volunteers at both the Prado Day Center and the Maxine Lewis Memorial Shelter and has coordinated a few dinners for the latter.

## **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

The HSOC voted to recommend the appointment of Anne Robin and Wendy Tyree at its March 5, 2014 meeting. The Clerk Recorder's office has confirmed that the terms of office are accurate and that the posting requirements have been met.

## **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

There are no financial considerations associated with these appointments.

## **RESULTS**

The immediate results of this action requested today will be to strengthen the HSOC by adding the expertise of Anne Robin and Wendy Tyree.
