SUBJECT: Request for consolidation of the City of Morro Bay Municipal Election with the June 3, 2014 Direct Primary Election. District 2.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the request by the City of Morro Bay for consolidation of the city's municipal election with the June 3, 2014 Direct Primary Election.

DISCUSSION

The City of Morro Bay has requested consolidation for the purpose of the municipal election for mayor and two city council members. All legal requirements for consolidation have been completed. Pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10402 et seq, the governing body shall approve the requests of cities to be consolidated with the upcoming election.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The City Council of Morro Bay has adopted a resolution requesting consolidation with the June 3, 2014 Direct Primary Election, attached.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Each entity that consolidates their election will be billed for their share of the cost based upon the number of registered voters in their jurisdiction and the cost of printing their information on the ballot and in the sample ballot. It is estimated that the cost to the City of Morro Bay for their pro-rata share of the election costs will be \$29,000.

RESULTS

That your Board comply with the Election Code by approving the consolidation request of the City of Morro Bay.
