I am writing to express my concerns regarding the proposed McDonalds in Los Osos which include the following:

2. Traffic - I drive into the Von's shopping center at least ten times a week. I belong to the gym, shop for groceries, purchase home improvement items at Miners and miscellaneous at Rite- Aid. I find the current parking lot to already be congested at peak times. It could only be worse by adding a McDonalds.

Dear Madam and Gentlemen:

Los Osos has many, many citizens who are not among the very vocal minority; we do not loudly and rudely proclaim our opposition to anything and everything that is proposed that we may or may not agree with. I am one of those citizens. I am a 17 year resident of Los Osos and I love living here.

Los Osos does not have a fast food restaurant available to its residents. If we want McDonalds, Burger King, Taco Bell, Jack-in-the-Box or Carl's Jr., or if we are out and about and want to grab a bite to eat after 9:00 p.m., we must drive to either Morro Bay or San Luis Obispo. Consider the amount of gas used and emissions traveling from Los Osos to either Morro Bay or San Luis Obispo. In addition, it is inconvenient and takes time.

The vocal minority argues that having a McDonald's restaurant will not bring new or additional business to the Von's shopping center; actually, I believe this is not true and, in addition, it will do the opposite as well. Businesses in the Von's shopping center will bring business to McDonald's. I can envision after buying gardening supplies at Miner's, stopping at McDonald's as a family for a Happy Meal and Fish Sandwich.

Another argument against allowing McDonald's in Los Osos is that McDonald's does not serve healthy food. Actually, Von's sells foods that are unhealthy, as do Sylvesters, Subway, Round Table Pizza and other restaurants in Los Osos. Both healthy and unhealthy foods can be purchased and eaten almost anywhere, including McDonald's. What others choose to eat is not my business, or the business of those objecting to McDonald's. In addition, where was the "healthy food police" when not one, but two smoke shops went in to little Los Osos? Smoking is far more hazardous to one's health than McDonalds!

The vocal minority believes the new McDonald's will be unsightly; I believe the large, empty Bank of America building is far more unsightly. Allowing McDonald's to go in at that location may encourage other businesses to rent the many vacant spaces in that shopping center, which are also now unsightly.

As far as having a drive-through, that would help alleviate any parking problems which may occur, although there is a lot of parking available at that site. It is true we are not located near a freeway; Arroyo Grande has drive-through restaurants that are not located near a freeway and they are successful.

I understand that there is a shortage of water. That is everywhere. The money that a McDonald's would bring into town may help pay for the sewer, find other sources of water, research methods for processing sea water for drinking or other uses.

Dear Elected Officials;

We are writing to let you know that as Los Osos residents, we are opposed to a fast-food restaurant in our community and, in particular, one with a drive-through and 24 hour service. While these so-called 'amenities' may be suited for large urban areas with strip-malls and high traffic volumes, they are totally unsuitable for Los Osos.

Surely you must be aware of the traffic patterns here in Los Osos; essentially a one-way in/out via Los Osos Valley Road. There is no traffic 'passing through' other than visitors to Montana de Oro. What traffic pattern revisions (ie...traffic lights) are projected in the plan to encourage random stops? We hike in Montana de Oro close to 4-5 times per week and the people we typically see would not likely be stopping for a meal at McDonalds before or after their visit to the State Park. And, if they are seeking a meal, why not encourage supporting one of our local businesses?

Since 'pass through' traffic is limited, if the intent of bringing McDonalds to Los Osos is to provide service to Los Osos residents, then let the residents decide. What have the analyst's numbers shown: to support a 24-hour McDonalds, how many meals per week (or day) would the average Los Osos citizen purchase and how much would they need to spend per each visit? Is this realistic and is it really in the best interest of all Los Osos residents (old and young) to eat so often at a fast-food restaurant? My husband and I purchase from McDonalds less than once per year (the last time was at the LAX airport in 2012) and it is not due to the lack of availability.

A drive-through is not going to entice someone to stop at a fast-food restaurant, and in fact, if they are going to be eating there, getting up and out of the car is essential for good health. Drive-throughs are not generally supported by people in sunny climates where it seldom rains; it's more supported by individuals in a hurry, rushing to get somewhere else...do we want to encourage these behaviors in our slow, laid-back town? What is the target market for an all-night fast food restaurant in a small community like Los Osos; I don't think it is my neighbors.

Please consider the overall and long term implications of a fast-food restaurant in Los Osos; you will agree that it does not fit here so **please vote to disapprove McDonalds presence in Los Osos.**

The Draft Estero Plan Update, approved by the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors in 2004, encouraged a pedestrian-oriented development. The California County of San Luis Obispo Board of Supervisors

The County of San Luis Obispo, the County Board of Supervisors, and particularly my District 2 Supervisor, Dr. Bruce Gibson; does have a *conflict of interest* in proceeding with, and voting on a use permit for the former Bank of America site in the Von's Shopping Center of Los Osos, California. (Attached). This conflict arose when the afore said parties and entities ignored numerous written inquiries and complaint, which stated; the Von's Shopping Center was non-compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act and is a car-less evacuation site for emergency planning zone 5, Los Osos.

Whereas the County of San Luis Obispo has excluded me from the remedy of an Administrative Complaint Process and rejected my concerns as a "Claim"; and whereas the County has excluded me from the economical remedy of protecting my personal health and safety; and whereas the County has excluded me from the economical remedy of successfully advocating for the special needs of the senior/disabled residents of Los Osos, California; I have NO other remedy but to first notify the County Board of Supervisors of their conflict and to move forward with legal action on specific aspects of my denied "Claim."

This is Notice of Intent to first bring suit against District 2 Supervisor Bruce Gibson in the Small Claims Court of the County of San Luis Obispo, in the matter of April 8, 2014, Hearing Item #19, before the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors, (Hearing to consider an appeal by MWF Properties LLC and McDonald's USA .)

The inaction of the District 2 Supervisor, Bruce Gibson, the County Board of Supervisors and the County of San Luis Obispo, now places said persons and entities in a unique position to take an action (vote), which would endanger me by increasing parking lot traffic in and around the Los Osos Von's Shopping Center. Such a vote of allowing a fast food restaurant in an area, which already requires me to compete with vehicle traffic as a qualified disabled individual most certainly will; significantly reduce my safety, further limit my mobility, and therefore limit my independence and community participation.

A use permit, which allows any fast food chain in the Von's Shopping Center of Los Osos,

(as identified in the attached map of the planning site), is known or should be known by the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors, its Department of Public Works, and its County Counsel; to pose a real and specific hazard to me. This hazard, and my attempts to remedy this hazard, is known to the County of San Luis Obispo since August 13, 2013. Identified in the attached map is the area in which I, and any mobility impaired senior/disabled resident must cross vehicle traffic to get onto the sidewalk of public business such as Rite-Aide Pharmacy, Von's Grocery, Ace Hardware, etc.

I am filing this small claims suite, as my health allows me, on specific issues found in my written August 13, 2014, Public Records Request, and my October 14, 2013 and January 27, 2014, Administrative Citizens Complaint; *which the County of San Luis Obispo has now rejected as a claim.*

I am filing in Small Claims Court, disallowing District 2 Supervisor, Bruce Gibson, from using the support of public funded County Counsel and because this is the most immediate, least adversarial means of remedy left to me.

As our elected officials please re-read the attached; "Findings Exhibit A" of Hearing Item 19.

Please recognize that *I am also a member of the general public.*

As a resident and member of the "general public," my District 2 Supervisor, in particular, and the County of San Luis Obispo, in general; has failed to act upon my concerns for ADA access to the Von's Shopping Center, in Los Osos.

Ignorance of the law is no excuse but my District 2 Supervisor, Bruce Gibson and the County of San Luis Obispo chose to ignore the law, (The Americans with Disabilities Act), and the public safety implications of a non-compliant shopping center and car-less evacuation site for emergency planning zone 5.

The Complainant chose to advocate, unsuccessfully on a level where decisions for her community are being made, rather than enrich herself by bring suit against a private property owner.

Placing soft curbs at the ends of the sidewalk to the Von's Shopping Center is now too little, too late. Construction from the Los Osos Waste Water Project has now damaged the entry area that could lead to potential access to the side-walk, (Attached). Neither the County of San Luis Obispo nor my District 2 Supervisor has addressed nor improved this ADA non-complaints but has made matters far worse for the senior/disabled demographic of Los Osos. In addition, Los Osos Dial-a-Ride program has been cut out, which would allow car-less residents in fragile health to safely access the Rite-Aid Pharmacy without competing with vehicles in the parking lot. The Para-Transit service does NOT offer same day rides for residents with urgent health needs.

My District 2 Supervisor, Bruce Gibson and the County of San Luis Obispo chose to ignore ADA access to the Von's Shopping Center as a health and safety concerns during the ongoing construction of the Los Osos Waste Water Project. Now the County of San Luis Obispo is being sued by a LOWWP contractor for mismanagement. My repeated, written concerns are readily found in the pages of the legal suite; ARB vs The County of San Luis

Obispo.

As a public advocate, I have shared photographs and videos during public comment with the County of San Luis Obispo and with LOCAC on the issue of the non-ADA compliance and senior/disabled persons competing with cars in the Von's shopping Center Parking lot at the proposed McDonald site.

The Complainant has exhausted herself while exhausting remedy.

Written communication to the County Board of Supervisors is seen below, in part, as it relates to the Counties conflict of interest on the use permit vote on April 8, 2014, and the Complainants intention to move forward with legal action on her denied "Claim;"

On August 13, 2013 the Complainant sent a written Public Records Request to the County of San Luis Obispo Board of Supervisors, including Supervisor Bruce Gibson.
The August 13, 2013 Public Records request was made;

"under the CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RECORDS ACT
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 1, 6250 ET SEQ, August 2004"

Included in the Public Request were three relative statements and a SLO County Board of Supervisors Minutes entry from April 20, 2004, as seen below in part;

"PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST

August 13, 2013"

"It is known that the coastal community of Los Osos, California has a demographic of transportation dependent, senior/disabled citizens."

"The Requester has publicly advocated for equity and inclusion of the senior/disabled population since 2003."

"The Requester has specifically advocated for the equal opportunity to *evacuate* and survive a PG&E event, as seen below, on April 20, 2004."

"Reverend C. Hite: addresses the people with disabilities and the unmet needs with regard to transportation in the case of an evacuation; asks for equal opportunity for the disabled during a PG&E alert;
states above-ground storage is an unacceptable risk."

1) I object that Evacuation Planning Zone 5, Los Osos, has a "carless" collection location of Vons Shopping Center, identified as LOVR near 10th Street. I object because this collection location is unspecific to pedestrians and the Vons Shopping Center is NOT ADA Complaint. (Attached) Therefore persons pushing wheelchairs and independent citizens with mobility devices will be unable to access the sidewalk at either end of the shopping center and will be forced into the parking lot, competing with vehicles attempting to evacuate.

2) I object that after nine years before the Board of Supervisors expressing my concerns for the equal opportunity to survive for the transportation dependent mothers, children and senior/disabled citizens; I was told, and the public was told that there was an evacuation transportation plan. However, evidence of such plan has yet to appear on the Regional Transit Authority web-site and just last week; such authority only just held bus driver training. I object because the San Luis Obispo County Regional Transit Authority, (SLORTA), are underpaid and cannot reasonably be expected to drive into a radiated evacuation planning zone for the purpose of picking up "carless" passengers.

6) I object to how my August 13, 2013 written public records request was handled. Each County Representative did receive and written copy by electronic mail. I claim that the County of San Luis Obispo Board of Supervisors are negligent for failing to address the issue of an updated evacuation plan for emergency Planning Zone 5, Los Osos, during ongoing construction of the Los Osos Wastewater Project. As each County Supervisor did

receive a copy of my Public Records Request and NO others, then someone chose to send said Request to the office of Public Works instead of the office of Emergency Services. I object because John Diodati has worked, and is expected to work with me on the location of sewer laterals. Therefore it is inappropriate for me to attempt to work with John Diodati on such a Public Records Request, which has now become a complaint.

"I object that the County of San Luis Obispo Board of Supervisors in NO way compensates me for my time, nor recognizes my efforts in pointing out the Counties failings to adequately and responsibly address the issues of evacuation of Emergency Planning Zone 5, Los Osos, during the ongoing construction of the Los Osos Waste-water Project. *My 8/14/13 Public Requests Request has NOT prompted adequate change.*"

On March 4, 2014, the Complainant sent a written Notice to each San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisor, including her District 2 Supervisor, expressing that "I am simply out of time." As seen below, the Complaint made clear and personal statements following a public comment regarding a shooting death in the very neighborhood identified as the one

most likely to access the proposed McDonald's in the Von's Shopping Center. Within this immediate neighborhood, clearly seen in the County attachments for Hearing Item 19; there are three car-less disabled families with power chairs and mobility scooters who will attempt, or have attempted to access businesses found near or at the corner of 10th and Los Osos Valley Road, also known as the Von's Shopping Center in Los Osos, California. The Complainants March 4, 2014, reads in part;

"We have NO remedy through our elected officials and the County of San Luis Obispo."

"I will NOT file an Administrative Complaint on this matter only to have the County again exclude me from this complaint process."

"On numerous occasions my elected officials and County staff have discouraged me and excluded me from basic participation in government processes; as if I am not a resident, as if I am not a citizen."

"Yet as a citizen and resident I have been selected as a Juror and again been called for Jury duty in San Luis Obispo County. I have recently competed in a California art competition and will now represent my County as an accepted exhibitor. I volunteer my time, my talents to numerous worthy causes."

"But by contrast; the expense; the time and effort I have expended simply trying to go about my daily life activities and protect my rights has been met with apathy on the part of my elected officials, the County, its Partners, contractors and sub-contractors."

"My eleven years of advocacy before my elected officials at the County Board of Supervisors is a failed advocacy."

"I am simply out of time."

"I am therefore giving notice to my elected officials and the bureaucracy, which is the County of San Luis Obispo."

"We will resolve the matter of the Counties indifference and neglect in court."

"You have been notified."
