RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO  
AUTHORIZING THE SURPLUS AND DONATION OF COMPUTER WORKSTATIONS TO  
CUESTA COLLEGE AND LUCIA MAR UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo currently owns 335 computer workstations; and

WHEREAS, these computer stations are outdated and no longer meet the County's equipment standards and requirements; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors has the authority under Government Code section 25372 to declare County property surplus and to donate County surplus property to, among others, school districts, and community colleges; and

WHEREAS, Cuesta College, a community college within the meaning of Government Code Section 25372, has stated the need for the 235 workstations for educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, Lucia Mar Unified School District has stated the need for the 100 workstations for educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public to surplus and donate these computer workstations to Cuesta College and Lucia Mar Unified School District, all which are no longer required for County use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Government Code section 25372, the Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors hereby declares as surplus property, no longer needed for County use, 335 Dell Optiplex workstations, "as-is", with all faults and without any software or warranties;

2. The Board of Supervisors hereby donates the surplus 335 computer workstations to Cuesta College and Lucia Mar Unified School District for educational purposes at no cost to the school district or community college;
3. The County Purchasing Agent is authorized to take such further actions as are required, if any, to complete the donation of these items of personal property.
