RESOLUTION ADOPTING A REVISED COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION PLAN FOR
THE COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (hereinafter referred to as “HUD”) requires the County of San Luis Obispo (hereinafter referred to as “County”) to have a Community Participation Plan (hereinafter referred to “Plan”) to establish procedures for public involvement when preparing or amending the annual Action Plans or the Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, HUD requires certain updates to the existing Plan pursuant to Title 24 CFR, Part 91, to provide public outreach strategies to local and regional institutions, the Continuum of Care, philanthropic organizations, and community and faith-based organizations; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the updates required by HUD, the County proposes to utilize more effective public outreach platforms and therefore to reduce the minimum number of public workshops, change the public noticing process, and to reallocate the Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (the “TBRA”) program income funds to the TBRA program under the administrative amendment process; and

WHEREAS, the revisions to the Community Participation Plan add the following provisions:

- a. Conduct public outreach strategies to local and regional institutions, the Continuum of Care, philanthropic organizations, and community and faith-based organizations to comply with the new Emergency Solutions Grant (“ESG”) program requirements.

- b. Reduce the minimum number of public workshops from four to two public workshops and change the public noticing process from a 30-day to a 15-day notice.
- c. Include other related public outreach strategies such as focused surveys and social media platforms to effectively engage public participation.
- d. Allow reallocation of program income funds generated from the Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) program to the TBRA program under “administrative” amendment process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

- 1. The Recitals set out above are true and correct.
- 2. The County of San Luis Obispo adopts the revised Community Participation Plan attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated by reference as though set forth in full herein pursuant to Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 91.
- 3. The County of San Luis Obispo authorizes the Director of Building and Planning to execute and transmit the Plan and to take any and all other actions necessary for its implementation.
