**APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECEIPT
OF FUNDS FROM THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY
CORRECTION (BSCC) TO BE USED FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION
OF THE COUNTY GANG TASK FORCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013/14**

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors desires to continue the operation of the County Gang Task Force, to be funded in part from funds made available through the Anti Drug Abuse Enforcement Team Grant Program supported by the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program funds, and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as the BSCC); and

WHEREAS, the San Luis Obispo County Sheriff's Office and partnering entities will abide by the statutes and regulations governing the federal Justice Assistance Grant Program as well as the terms and conditions of the grant agreement as set forth by the BSCC; and

WHEREAS, federal grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, hereby:

1. Certifies that the Sheriff-Coroner of San Luis Obispo County is authorized on behalf of this governing board to submit the grant application for this funding and sign the grant agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments or modifications thereto; and
2. Adopts this resolution approving the receipt of grant funds to be used for the continued operation of the County Gang Task Force.


