Dear Mr. Buckshi:

I am out of state and unable to attend the Board's regular meeting this Tuesday, 7/15/14. There is an important agenda item regarding the County's financial support of the new Homeless Service Center at 40 Prado.

I would very much appreciate you sharing this letter with the Supervisors who will vote on the measure to allocate \$500,000.00 for the building at 40 Prado. Others will speak regarding the status of the property, present financial picture, and fundraising plans relative to the first phase.

As you know, I have been intimately involved with this project for several years. We are at a stage where the County's support is critical. Momentum is building and the County's continued partnership with the cities in SLO County, the non-profits providing services to the homeless, and this Foundation which represents the entire County is important. Underscoring this County wide effort was my discussion with the mayor's at their monthly meeting on 7/11 in Arroyo Grande. There was clear and firm agreement that homelessness is a regional issue that benefits greatly from the partnership of the governing agencies, non-profits and communities.

The building of the HSC represents more than a building. It represents the increasing cooperation between non-profits to provide better, more effective and comprehensive services, more insightful governmental oversight relative to funding and a better informed public that will, in greater numbers and with more enthusiasm, support with volunteerism and donations the new center and ongoing services. This is a unique opportunity for the County to provide leadership regarding this issue and continue being a partner in the building at 40 Prado and the future of services in this County for those who are working to regain sustainability.

Thank you for your continued support and that of the Board of Supervisors who have previously voted with the Boards of RTA and SLOCOG to purchase the property at 40 Prado that now represents the future of the new transit hub; but also the HSC on 3.2 acres which is secured and debt free.
