**RESOLUTION DENYING THE REQUEST FOR A WAIVER OF PUBLIC FACILITY FEES
BY COASTAL CHRISTIAN SCHOOL FOR FEES ASSOCIATED WITH CONSTRUCTION
PERMITS FOR THE MODULAR UNITS INTENDED TO SERVE AS THE INTERIM

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2014, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo (hereafter Board of Supervisors) duly considered and denied the public facility fee waiver request of Coastal Christian School associated with construction permits for the modular units to serve as the interim campus for Coastal Christian School.

EXHIBIT A

FINDINGS

- A. Coastal Christian School has not demonstrated an absence of any reasonable relationship or nexus between the impacts of the development project and the amount of the fee charged.
- B. A reasonable relationship and nexus exists between the construction of new private educational facilities and increased demand for public facilities, because:
 - 1. Students and faculty associated with the school will generate demands upon parks, libraries, and other government facilities; and
 - 2. The campus will receive fire protection and police protection services from County/Cal Fire and the County Sheriff, respectively.
- C. The increased demand for public facilities will occur during the 10 year period while the temporary campus is in place.
