SUBJECT: Request to approve the appointments of Amy Christey and Rick Gulino to the Homeless Services Oversight Council (HSOC). All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the appointment of Amy Christey and Rick Gulino to the Homeless Services Oversight Council (HSOC) for terms expiring on January 1, 2017.

DISCUSSION

The composition of the HSOC is meant to be diversified, using the collaboration of individuals and agencies to provide guidance and oversight for the on-going implementation of the 10-Year Plan.

Efforts to achieve full membership for the HSOC are ongoing and this item recommends two applicants for appointment to fill a vacant Law Enforcement seat and a vacant Affordable Housing seat.

Due to the resignation of Jim Copsey, there is currently a vacant seat on the HSOC for a representative of a law enforcement agency. Due to the resignation of Jeanette Duncan following her retirement from People's Self Help Housing, there is currently a vacancy in the affordable housing developer seat on the HSOC. To fill these seats, HSOC recently met to consider applications from Amy Christey and Rick Gulino to fill the positions. The group voted to recommend both applicants for membership to the HSOC.

Amy Christey is a member of the San Luis Obispo County Criminal Justice Administrators Association (CJAA) and is the Police Chief for the City of Morro Bay. She participates regularly in the Estero Bay Alliance for Care (EBAC) and collaborates regularly with nonprofit service providers to address the needs of homeless persons in Morro Bay. She worked for 20 years as a law enforcement professional in Santa Cruz County, where she operated a community substation and was involved in local homeless issues. In that position, she also developed and implemented a nonprofit youth activity program for at-risk low income youth in Santa Cruz County. She has been recommended for membership to the HSOC by the CJAA.

Rick Gulino is the Director of Neighborhood Development for People's Self Help Housing (PSHH). He also sits on the Board of the 5 Cities Homeless Coalition and currently chairs the San Luis Obispo Supportive Housing Consortium. He has worked for PSHH for the past five years. In his current position, he is responsible for overseeing placement of homeless persons into housing units operated by PSHH and ensuring housing stability once clients are placed. He is currently Jeanette Duncan's alternate to the HSOC.

The Maddy Act requires that the Board of Supervisors approve all changes to HSOC membership. This report requests approval of the HSOC's recommendations.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The HSOC voted to recommend the appointments of Amy Christey and Rick Gulino at its July 16, 2014 meeting. The Clerk Recorder's office has confirmed the terms of office are accurate and that the posting requirements have been met.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

There are no financial considerations associated with these appointments.

RESULTS

The immediate results of the action requested today will be to strengthen the HSOC by adding the expertise of Amy Christey and Rick Gulino.
