RE: Item 14 Temporary Event at Santa Margarita Ranch

Dear Chairman Gibson and Supervisors,

I request that you adopt the following requirements as conditions for approval for Temporary Event activities at the Santa Margarita Ranch being requested by the Sunset Savor Event.

- o Close the Yerba Buena Avenue entrance to ALL pre-event, event and post-event traffic. Require all traffic to enter/exit at China Gardens, except in the event of an emergency. Place notices closing the street to all except Residents only.
- o Limit the event to a maximum of 3000 participants including event staff.
- o Until a permanent left turn lane is constructed at the China Gardens entrance per Public Works requirement, require all attendees utilize shuttles from the Santa Barbara Park and Ride. In fact, directing traffic from Santa Barbara south on ECR/Highway 58 to China Gardens entrance will be a right hand turn limiting the left turn across traffic. A right turn upon exiting China Gardens routed on ECR/Highway 58 through the town of Santa Margarita then sends traffic direct to Highway 101.
- o In the future, require that all traffic plans, safety plans etc. be available for public review prior to the hearing before your board.
- o Prohibit the idling of engines and consult APCD for mitigation measures on carbon monoxide emissions, noise and dust and dirt pollution.

- o Require traffic counting devices to be put in place on Yerba Buena Avenue, El Camino Real North and South of China Gardens, Yerba Buena Avenue, and INSIDE the Santa Margarita Ranch entrance to obtain an accurate traffic count and ascertain impacts of the event by traffic within Santa Margarita.
- o Require this to be a Non-Smoking event.
- o Require additional onsite water storage for fire and safety reasons.
- o Require access at all times at China Gardens for emergency response.
- o Require that the permit application for the 2015 event be processed and calendared on the Supervisors' agenda at least 90 days before the event.
- o Require an annual permit for this event.
