Honorable Chairman Gibson:

The City of San Luis Obispo supports the request for a three (3) year contract for housing, placement, and support services which will provide assistance to the chronically homeless.

Pursuant to City's Legislative Action Platform for 2014, the City advocates programs under the McKinney-Vento Act, which includes, but is not limited to, health services, support services, shelter and transitional housing for the homeless. The City has also adopted the following Major City Goal as a top priority in the 2013-15 Financial Plan: *Implement Comprehensive Strategies to Address Homelessness*. This Major City Goal proposes increased services and associated funding where outcomes support additional services to homeless populations. A three year contract with Transitions Mental Health Association will assist 50 of the County's most vulnerable homeless people receive and retain permanent housing and furthers our common goal of addressing chronic homelessness. We continue to strongly value the partnership and relationships with the County and look forward to our continued support of the community's focus on this important issue.

For these reasons, the City of San Luis Obispo supports the proposal.
