DISCUSSION

Each year the Board joins the nation and many states in commemorating October as "Domestic Violence Awareness Month". The public designation of this special month helps to highlight this serious category of crime and increase our awareness of what communities can do to help the victims of domestic violence deal effectively with offenders and to institute programs to prevent domestic violence.

Since 1994, the District Attorney's Office has provided the leadership to support a collaboration of public and private agencies committed to improving our community's response to domestic violence. The San Luis Obispo County Domestic Violence Task Force joins the Victim/Witness Center, San Luis Obispo Women's Shelter Program, RISE, Department of Social Services, The Health Department and others in requesting the Board to make this proclamation highlighting "Domestic Violence Awareness Month."
