**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)  
TRANSITION PLAN 2014 UPDATE**

**RECITALS:**

The following resolution is now offered and read:

**WHEREAS**, the Federal government enacted the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) to prevent discrimination of the physically and mentally disabled relating to employment and access to public facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the 1973 Rehabilitation Act and Title II of the ADA requires that municipalities adopt a Transition Plan that documents barriers to accessibility, proposed structural modifications to remove those barriers, and a schedule to complete the modifications; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department completed a self-assessment/Transition Plan in 2000. The updated plan includes a grievance policy and guidelines for public facilities including curb ramps, traffic signals, disabled person parking, sidewalks and potential funding with associated capital road projects; and

**WHEREAS**, ADA design standards have been modified by the Federal government since the preparation of the 2000 Transition Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the County remains committed to the ADA and the elimination of barriers to public facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has prepared an update to the 2000 Transition Plan to reflect current County infrastructure and ADA design standards, persons designated to implement the plan and a grievance policy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

1. Adopt the ADA Transition Plan for Pedestrian Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way in compliance with 28 CFR Part 35, Section 150, a copy of which shall be filed with and maintained by the County Clerk.
2. Designate the Director of Public Works as the ADA Coordinator for the Public Right-of-Way and the person to implement the plan and the grievance policy in compliance with 49 CFR Part 27, Section 27.13.
3. The ADA Transition Plan adopted herein shall supersede and replace any of the County's current ADA planning document related to the Public Right-of-Way.
