SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution authorizing execution of the notice of completion and acceptance of construction for the Bridge Painting Project, Various County-wide Bridges, San Luis Obispo County. Districts 1, 2, 3 and 5.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution which authorizes the execution of a notice of completion and acceptance of the construction for the Bridge Painting Project, Various County Bridges, (Contract No. 245R12B580).

DISCUSSION

The contract was awarded by your Board to FD Thomas, Inc. on May 13, 2014 in the amount of \$657,111 and was constructed within the allowable working days.

The project provided for painting the bridge steel components showing signs of paint deterioration and rusting on seven bridges in the County. These bridges are as follows:

- Tassajara Creek Road Bridge
- Stenner Creek Road Bridge
- Las Pilitas Road Bridge B-2
- Las Pilitas Road Bridge B-3
- Buckley Road Bridge
- Park Hill Road Bridge
- Chimney Rock Road Bridge

The scope of work included a full containment system with ground and air quality testing to prevent discharges during blast-cleaning the existing structural steel, handling and disposal of the spent blast media, painting of the structural steel, and avoidance of site disturbance at all seven bridges.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Construction funding was authorized for this project through the Federal Highway Bridge Program (HBP), which is administered by Caltrans.

Environmental Documents were processed under the Environmental Coordinator.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This project is a multi-year maintenance project budgeted in Road Fund at \$1,125,000. The estimated final project costs to clean and paint various bridges is \$926,116. The project will be funded from Federal Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program – Local (BPMPL) in the amount of \$801,546 and Road Fund in the amount of \$124,570. No budget adjustment is necessary.

A final report of actual project costs will be filed with the clerk after any and all claims, disputes and adjustments have been resolved. We do not anticipate the final project cost to differ materially from the current estimated total. Five percent (5%) of total contractor payments are held by the County and released only after meeting the legal holding period after the Notice of Completion is filed.

Please see Exhibit “A” for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

RESULTS

By taking the recommended action, the Board will cause the legal Notice of Completion for this construction contract to be recorded and start the period of time during which liens can be filed by subcontractors against the prime contractor. This provides for a well-governed community.
