SUBJECT: Request to approve an agreement with the South County Historical Society allocating \$1,744 from District Four Community Grant Funds – Fund Center #106 to be used for expenses associated with the construction of the Pacific Coast Railway interpretive kiosk in the City of Arroyo Grande. District 4.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the agreement allocating \$1,744 from District Four Community Grant Funds - Fund Center #106, to the South County Historical Society to be used for expenses associated with the construction of the Pacific Coast Railway interpretive kiosk in the City of Arroyo Grande.

DISCUSSION

The South County Historical Society is dedicated to the research, restoration and dissemination of information pertinent to the historical heritage of the South County. The Society supports four (4) historical museums that showcase the area's history. All the museums are open to the public. The Society continues to work on the construction of an outdoor interpretive display (kiosk) in the Village of Arroyo Grande that will showcase the Pacific Coast Railway between 1876 and 1940. The purpose is to highlight the parts of the County that were served by the narrow gauge railway during this time period. The kiosk will be part of Arroyo Grande's walking tour when it is completed.

The \$1,744 in County funds will be used towards expenses associated with construction of the Pacific Coast Railway kiosk including side and center display panels, heartwood coast redwood ties, and an artist's depiction of Chinese workers.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The South County Historical Society will oversee the construction of the Pacific Coast Railway kiosk.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Funding in the amount of \$1,744 will be allocated from District Four Community Project Grant Funds - Fund Center #106, to the South County Historical Society.

RESULTS

Funds will be used for expenses associated with construction of the Pacific Coast Railway kiosk including side and center display panels, heartwood coast redwood ties, and an artist's depiction of Chinese workers. The intent of the kiosk is to educate the public about the historical heritage of the South County.
