Re: Support for Recommended Model Refinements and Additional Model Runs

On December 4, 2014, the Computer Model Update Subcommittee of the Paso Basin Advisory Committee (BAC) met (in person and via conference call) and reviewed the Draft Report Outcome and the Draft Executive Summary for the Basin Model Update. The consultants who performed the model update (GEOSCIENCE and Todd Groundwater), as well as the 3<sup>rd</sup> party technical reviewer (Fugro Consultants), were available to answer questions. Several members of the public were in attendance.

The consensus of the subcommittee was to support the recommended model refinements and additional model runs. This work effort is necessary to resolve some technical issues and to ensure that the model is a useful tool for basin management.

At the December 18, 2014 BAC meeting, the Computer Model Update Subcommittee requested that the BAC submit a letter to the Board of Supervisors to support the recommendations and to provide funding as needed for these efforts, which the BAC unanimously approved.

The Paso Basin Advisory Committee requests that the Board of Supervisors support the recommendations for model refinement and additional model runs, as outlined in the "Paso Robles Groundwater Model Update, Draft Final Report Outcome and Proposed Next Steps, as of December 4, 2014" and provide funding as needed for these efforts.
