SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution authorizing execution of the notice of completion and acceptance of construction for the South Higuera Street Rehabilitation Project near San Luis Obispo. District 3.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution, which authorizes the execution of a notice of completion and acceptance of the construction for the South Higuera Street Rehabilitation Project near San Luis Obispo. (Contract No. 245R12B623).

DISCUSSION

Higuera Street, between the southerly city limit of San Luis Obispo and the bridge over San Luis Creek, was originally constructed in the late 1920's and served as the previous alignment of State Route 101. The original concrete surface exists over much of this segment but settlement over the decades has resulted in a rough ride for motorists. This portion of Higuera Street was identified under our Pavement Management Program for rehabilitation work.

The contract was awarded by your Board to Souza Construction, Inc. on September 9, 2014 in the amount of \$195,977. The project was constructed within the allowable working days, and was completed on December 22, 2014.

The project for rehabilitation retained the concrete surface and improved the ride quality by grinding to remove surface irregularities and faulting of the concrete slabs at joints and sealed existing cracks. This is a standard practice on concrete roads which remain structurally adequate to serve traffic. In addition, work included short sections of asphalt overlay for areas over existing culverts which had significant settlement in the past. The existing south bound bike lane received an asphalt seal treatment that will extend pavement life.

Southern California Gas Company will be upgrading a transmission line, and as a result, reconstructing the northbound bike lane this spring.

A California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) categorical exemption for this project was filed on February 7, 2014. Project Specifications include best-management-practices for containment and disposal of any concrete grinding slurry generated from the project.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

There were no anticipated utility conflicts and therefore no utility relocations were necessary. All the work was done within the existing County right-of-way.

The Project Manager for the County of San Luis Obispo obtained an encroachment permit from the City of San Luis Obispo to place construction area signs within City limits.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is a multi-year maintenance repair project budgeted in the Road Fund FY 2014-15 at \$288,346. The total project costs are estimated at \$282,687. The project will be funded from the Road Fund. No budget adjustment is necessary.

A final report of actual project costs will be filed with the clerk after any and all claims, disputes and adjustments have been resolved. We do not anticipate the final project cost to differ materially from the current estimated total. Five percent (5%) of total contractor payments are held by the County and released only after meeting the legal holding period after the Notice of Completion is filed.

Please see Exhibit "A" for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

RESULTS

By taking the recommended action, the Board will cause the legal Notice of Completion for this construction contract to be recorded and start the period of time during which liens can be filed by subcontractors against the prime contractor.
