Dear Board Members.

Subject: Bob Jones EIR, Item 30 on the February 24th, 2015 Agenda.

I am writing to ask for your approval of the Final Bob Jones EIR, that is the on the Agenda for February 24th, 2015. The concept of this project has been in the works for more than 40 years. I was given photos taken back in 1973 where this was first discussed on the old Pacific Railroad Right of Way.

I believe this should be a high priority project for San Luis Obispo County Parks and associated Staff to get this done. We need to do what ever we can to move this project forward.

At the Parks and Recreation Hearing many questions were asked about doing things in parallel to help streamline the process.

Current High Priority in my minds are:

1. Complete the County Portion of the Octagon Barn Staging Area. Current

Plans are to start in 2016.

If there is any way we can move the forward into 2015. It would be greatly appreciated. In all cases we need to hold the schedule.

2. Start negotiating with local landowners that we have not contacted yet. I know the NEPA documents need to be approved before actual negotiations take place. But we have many landowners such as the Land Conservancy of SLO who are ready and willing to get their portions of easements, trail alignments and operating agreements in place. Prior to the NEPA documents being approved to help this project along.

3. I was glad to hear that we may be able to construct a portion of the Trail starting in 2017 from the Octagon Barn to Clover Ridge. This would be a good step forward in getting this project done. We need to do everything we can to hold and/ or improve this schedule.

4. Complete the section from Ontario Road Staging Area to San Luis Bay Drive. (Land Owner Negotiations will need to take place.)

5. Complete the section from Clover Ridge to San Luis Bay Drive. (Land Owner Negotiations will need to take place.)

In summary, I would ask the Board to approve the EIR and do what we can to hold and/or improve known portions of the Bob Jones City to Sea Schedule( Items 1,2 and 3). Then work items 4 and 5 in parallel to help get to the actual planning and development process sooner rather than later.
