**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH OFFICER  
AS THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE  
TO EXECUTE THE BEACH MONITORING AGREEMENT  
WITH THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD**

The following Resolution is hereby offered and read:

**WHEREAS**, the State Water Resources Control Board has determined that the County of San Luis Obispo is eligible to receive funds from the Public Beach Safety Program (Health and Safety Code Section 115881) and the Waste Discharge Permit Fund (Water Code Section 13260) in an amount not to exceed \$97,500 for the purpose of beach water quality monitoring and public notification (Services); and

**WHEREAS**, the County Health Officer is especially suited to ensure that the Services are carried out consistent with the Beach Monitoring Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

1. The County Health Officer or designee is hereby authorized to execute the Beach Monitoring Agreement (Agreement No. 14-466-250) with the State Water Resources Control Board.
2. The Health Officer or designee is hereby authorized to execute any future amendments or other documents related to or required for the administration of the Beach Monitoring Agreement (Agreement No. 14-466-250).
