**RESOLUTION COMMENDING CONNIE BOOTON
UPON HER RETIREMENT AFTER 31 YEARS OF SERVICE**

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, Connie Booton began her SLO County career August 2, 1971, as a Key punch Operator I and member of the Office of Technical Services.

WHEREAS, In 1977 Ms. Booton retired to care for her beautiful children Trevor and Lindsay.

WHEREAS, In 1981 Ms Booton returned to County employment as a Data Entry Operator and worked part-time temporary for the Sheriff, Social Services, Superior Court, County Hospital and the Auditor-Controller's Office.

WHEREAS, In 1985 Ms. Booton accepted a permanent position in the Auditor-Controller's Office and has been a valued member of the office for the past 30 years.

WHEREAS, During Ms. Booton's career as a Data Entry Operator she manually input over 325,000 time cards and over 100,000 vendor payments.

WHEREAS, In 2002 Ms. Booton was promoted to an Accounting Systems Aide and was given the task of providing desktop support for the Auditor-Controller's Office.

WHEREAS, Ms. Booton has had to restore the Auditor-Controller's computer three times for user errors which she politely referred to as hardware problems.

WHEREAS, The entire office relied on Ms. Booton's desktop management skills and experienced unflappable service with a smile.

WHEREAS, Ms. Booton is known and widely respected throughout the County for her work ethic, attention to critical detail, positive attitude, patient manner, and unquestioned integrity.

WHEREAS, In her personal life Ms. Booton has been an officer or Board member of the San Luis Obispo Blues Society since the early 90s, bringing excellent blues performers such as Elvin Bishop, Harmonica Fats, Guitar Shorty, Chambers Brothers, Dave Miller Band, Robert Cray, and John Lee Hooker to the Central Coast.

WHEREAS, Ms. Booton served as a role model for a healthy work/life balance and allowed others to live vicariously through her vacation adventures.

WHEREAS, Ms. Booton has decided to take a long deserved rest from her working career after 31 total years of County employment and can now sleep in every morning.

WHEREAS, Ms. Booton's warm smile and soft laugh will be missed by the entire department.
