### Rating Criteria

During the FY 2015 competitive grant application process for allocation of County CDBG, HOME, and ESG funds, the County evaluated and ranked the grant applications received using the objective point system (Maximum = 31 points) based on the following seven (7) criteria:

1. Consistency with federal regulations and laws - *7 points*
2. Community support (for example, approval of project by a City Council) – *3 points*
3. Seriousness of community development need proposed to be addressed by project – *3 points*
4. Degree to which project benefits low-income and very low-income families or persons – *3 points*
5. Feasibility of the project to be completed as budgeted or by May 31, 2016 for public service activities, planning and capacity building and administrative costs, or by December 31, 2015 for projects involving acquisition, construction or rehabilitation – *6 points*
6. Cost effectiveness of funds requested and leveraging of other funds – *3 points*
7. Organization's experience or knowledge regarding CDBG, HOME or ESG – *6 points*
