RECOMMENDATION

In accordance with applicable State Law, it is our recommendation that the Board:

1. Approve the project and adopt the plans and specifications for the construction of 2014-15 Micro Surfacing, Los Osos, Contract No. 300528; and
2. Authorize the contract to be advertised for construction bids. The recommended bid opening date is Thursday, May 21, 2015; and
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DISCUSSION

The Los Osos micro surfacing contract is in coordination with the previously approved asphalt overlay project in Los Osos to address the road system now that the wastewater collection system has been completed. The work is necessary to rehabilitate residential streets and halt further deterioration of existing pavements. This contract provides for micro-surfacing on 30 miles of roads. The contract also includes additive bid items which could be included in the contract, if the bids are favorable, for the Vista De Oro Estates and Oak Ridge subdivisions, as well as the El Moro bike path for specialized color seal coat. In addition, a separate project to upgrade the existing ADA ramps will be performed as an informal bid contract and precedes the micro-surfacing to comply with Federal regulations.

Micro surfacing is one of the most versatile tools used for road maintenance and is a preferred treatment for aging County roads which still have structural integrity. It is a polymer-modified cold-mix paving system that can restore the wearing surface and extend the pavement life.

This project will be constructed using a combination of County forces and private contractors. County crews have already prepared the road surface by filling any pot holes, sealing cracks in the pavement and removing any raised pavement markings. The contractor will apply the micro surfacing. This combination is part of the Pavement Management Plan maintenance strategy to increase the overall miles of roadway treated each year.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Various utility companies have been contacted including the Los Osos Community District and the Golden State Water Company in consideration of project impacts to their facilities.

Staff has reviewed the pavement treatments and subsequent traffic striping with the Los Osos Community Advisory Council.

The County Clerk formally processes the bid openings.

County Counsel has approved the contract as to legal form and effect.

The County Environmental Coordinator has reviewed the project and determined that it is exempt from CEQA.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is a Pavement Management project budgeted in the Road Fund FY 2014-15. The total project costs are estimated at \$1,278,203. Funding for the project will come from the Road Fund - Pavement Management Program.

At the time of Award, when actual project costs are known, we will return to the Board with a budget adjustment, if necessary.

Please see Exhibit A for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

RESULTS

Approval of the recommended action will result in this project being advertised for construction bids. The micro surface construction will lead to meeting the performance based budget objectives and provide a safer and more livable community.
