RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MENTALLY ILL OFFENDER CRIME
REDUCTION GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo Behavioral Health Department desires to participate in the Mentally Ill Offender Crime Reduction Grant Program, funded through the State Recidivism Reduction Fund and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Health Agency Director is authorized on behalf of this Governing Board to submit the grant proposal for this funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, will sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, if awarded, including any amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that state grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that County of San Luis Obispo Behavioral Health Department agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project and abide by the statutes and regulations governing the State Grants Program (including General Terms and Conditions 610) as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.


