SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution establishing a bikeway naming policy for bikeways under Public Works jurisdiction. All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution establishing a bikeway naming policy for bikeways under Public Works jurisdiction.

DISCUSSION

To establish a uniform process for naming County bikeways, Public Works prepared the policy attached as Exhibit "A" of the resolution. The Draft policy was brought to the County Bicycle Advisory Committee in November 2014 and was approved unanimously with no modifications. The attached policy is consistent with previous Board action naming bikeways and the Naming County Recreational Facilities Policy used by San Luis Obispo County Parks.

The procedure will allow for bikeway naming based on geographical location, historical significance or to recognize individuals who have made a significant financial or service contribution to San Luis Obispo County bicycling community.

Previously, the Board had named three (3) bikeways for members of the cycling community. In April 1996, the O'Connor Way bike lanes were named for Wayne Williams; in November 2002, the Foothill Boulevard bike lanes were named for Bob Garing; and in March 2003, the bike bridge near the Cayucos water treatment plant was named for Colin Reilly. All of the men were well recognized bicycle advocates for San Luis Obispo County.

Staff recommends the Board adopt the attached resolution to establish a bikeway naming policy for bikeways under Public Works jurisdiction.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The Bikeway Naming Policy was developed from the *Naming County Recreational Facilities* policy used by San Luis Obispo County Parks. The Bikeway Naming Policy was reviewed and approved by the County Bicycle Advisory Committee at the November 2014 meeting.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

There is no financial impact associated with this action. In the future, placement of signs is estimated to cost less than \$1,000 per bikeway. New signage installations will be limited to once every (5) years. The financial impact associated with naming a bikeway will be addressed in the future as they are brought to the Board for adoption.

RESULTS

Adoption of this resolution will establish a policy for naming bikeways and recognizing individuals who have made a significant contribution to cycling in San Luis Obispo County, thus improving community livability and providing for a well governed community.
