RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt a resolution proclaiming May 2015 as "Older Americans Month" in San Luis Obispo County.

DISCUSSION

Each year, the State and the nation commemorate May as "Older Americans Month" to highlight the special needs of our senior citizens and their contributions to our society. In April 1999, the Board formally recognized the Adult Services Policy Council (ASPC) as the countywide collaborative tasked with providing planning, development and system design and service integration to improve and expand services for adults and seniors. The ASPC target populations are seniors and adults with disabilities who utilize publicly funded health and human services. The recognition of "Older Americans Month" by our Board of Supervisors underscores the role of older Americans in shaping our communities and the work of the ASPC to improve the lives of the elderly in San Luis Obispo County.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT:

Many agencies in our community provide services and support to seniors in our county such as: the Area Agency on Aging, AIDS Support Network & SLO Hep C Project, Alzheimer's Association, Area Agency on Aging, Community Action Partnership of SLO County, Community Health Centers, Hospice of San Luis Obispo County, Independent Living Resource Center, Ride-On Transportation, Senior Legal Services Project, Senior Nutrition Program, Transitions/Mental Health Association, Tri-Counties Regional Center, United Cerebral Palsy, United Way of San Luis Obispo County, Wilshire Community Services and many more public and private agencies who provide necessary services that support independent living. Many activities in our county are supported by the volunteer efforts of the older citizens of our county through RSVP Senior Volunteer Service and other community agencies and organizations.
