SUBJECT: Request by the San Luis Obispo County Tourism Business Improvement District (CBID) to appoint Michelle Latham to the Cambria Local Area Advisory Board. District 2.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board appoint Michelle Latham to the Cambria Local Area Advisory Board to finish Charlie Yates' term which expires January 31, 2016.

DISCUSSION

The ordinance establishing the San Luis Obispo County Tourism Business Improvement District (CBID) was originally approved by the Board in May 2009 and subsequently renewed in May since then. The ordinance (Section 3.09.050) provides for an assessment on all lodging businesses (hotels, motels, bed and breakfasts, vacation rentals), existing and future, within the boundaries of the CBID based upon 2% of the paid rent charged by the operator per occupied room per night for all transient occupancies. Fifty percent (50%) of the assessment is to be used for marketing and promoting the entire CBID area; the other 50% is to be used to promote tourism in the Local Area from where the funds are collected (Section 3.09.080).

In accordance with the ordinance, the Board, at the recommendation of the CBID Advisory Board, on December 7, 2010, designates the local areas of the unincorporated business improvement district to be:

- Avila Beach
- Arroyo Grande unincorporated/San Luis Obispo unincorporated
- Cambria
- Cayucos
- Los Osos/Morro Bay unincorporated
- Nipomo/Oceano
- San Simeon

At that same meeting, the Board's approved the Local Area By-laws which set out how the local area boards will be organized and appointed (Article II attached). Members of the Local Area Advisory Board shall be appointed according to the provisions of Government Code Section 54970 (Maddy Book). The Clerk-Recorder has posted the Advisory Board vacancies according to this government code section.

The Cambria Local Area Advisory Board was formed on February 1, 2011 when the Board approved appointments to the Board according to the provisions of Government Code Section 54970 (Maddy Book). On March 10, 2015, Charlie Yates resigned from his Advisory Board position. On May 12, 2015, the Cambria Advisory Board approved recommending that Michelle Latham be appointed in his place.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Lodging businesses within the Cambria designated local area met to form and determine the organization of their advisory boards. As noted above, the Cambria Local Area Advisory Board is recommending the appointment of Michelle Latham. The vacancy was posted was posted by the Clerk-Recorder.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

None.

RESULTS

This action continues the implementation of the local area provisions of the County Business Improvement District ordinance. The County does not establish performance criteria for the local areas beyond the legal contractual obligations to expend the funds for identified purposes.
